NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The above well is posted on 3/21/2014, for a violation of West Virginia 35 CSR Series 4, Section 7, a Legislative rule of the Office of Oil and Gas of the Department of Environmental Protection, set forth in detail as follows:

§35-4-7. Operational Regulation on Liquid Injection and Disposal Wells

7.3. Pre-Operational Certificate

7.3.a. The Chief or his appointed representative shall be notified no less than twenty-four (24) hours prior to mechanical integrity testing to allow the Chief or his representative the opportunity to witness the tests. Copies of the results of all the tests shall be submitted with Form WR-37 as provided in subdivision 7.3.b.

7.3.b. Upon successful completion and mechanical integrity testing, and prior to first injection into a permitted liquid injection or waste disposal well, the operator shall furnish the office with a certificate on Form WR-37, "Pre-Operation Certificate for Liquid Injection or Waste Disposal Well," indicating that all requirements of subsections 7.1 and 7.2 have been satisfied.

Findings are delinquent reporting of certificate Form WR-37 to the Office of Oil and Gas.

To abate the violation you must: Have successfully performed a mechanical integrity test using the procedures required and submit a complete certificate Form WR-37 to the Office of Oil and Gas.


A copy of this notice has been sent by certified or registered mail to the person or Designated Agent named above.

You are hereby granted until 3/28/2014, to abate this violation.

Failure to abate the violation by that date will result in bond forfeiture and may result in assessment of civil penalties, filing of misdemeanor charges and/or an action for injunctive relief.

An informal conference with the Oil and Gas inspector should be arranged prior to the date set forth above for abatement of the violation.

If you wish to contest this violation, refer to procedures outlined in West Virginia Code 22-6-4.
