John Starkay and
being first duly sworn according to law depose and say that they are experienced in the work of plugging and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by South Penn Oil Co, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the 18th day of October, 1929, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged: Total depth of well 2076 ft. Top of tools left in hole was 1888 ft. Depth to mandril at bottom of tools was 1936 ft. Filled up with cement from 1936 ft. to 1758 ft. Drove 6 5/8" Common Wood Dry Hole Plug to 1609 ft. The 6 5/8" casing parted while working at the well and top of 6 5/8" left in hole was 1609 ft. steel line measurement. Placed 17 ft. of cement on top of 6 5/8" wood plug. Shut in 42 hours and found no gas escaping by fire test. Pulled 6 5/8" casing. There was 358 ft. 6 5/8" casing left in hole. Bridged hole at 268 ft. Drove 8 1/2" Common Wood Dry Hole Plug to 268 ft. Then filled up with clay to within ten feet of surface. Put in Manner in which coal was plugged: four feet of rock and set up marker which extended above surface 4 ft. This marker was a piece of 8 1/2" casing 10 ft. long, six feet being in ground and 4 ft. above ground. This marker was filled with stone and clay within 18" of top. Then 18" of cement was put in top of marker.

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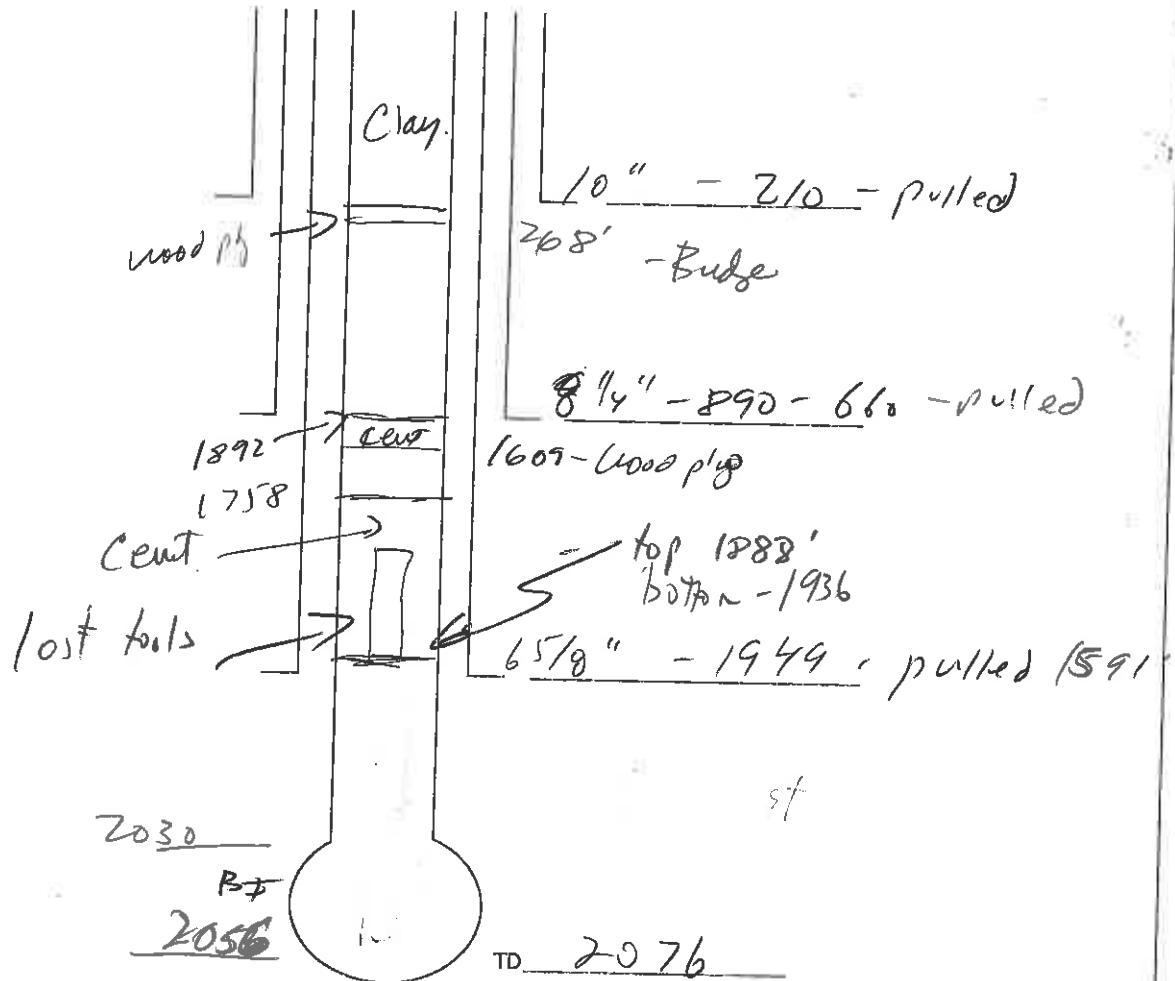
