NOTICE OF VIOLATION

The above well is being posted on 8/17/2017, for a violation of 35 CSR 4 .12.2(a). a Legislative rule of the Office of Oil and Gas of the Department of Environmental Protection.

On April 25, 2017, Office of Oil and Gas issued a fracture well work permit for well 47-039-02210. OOG Inspector Terry Urban was not contacted prior to the initiation of the work. A Well Operator's Report of Well Work "WR-35 form" was not submitted in the allotted ninety (90) days.

Legislative Rule 35CSR4-12.2.a. "Within ninety (90) days after the completion of permitted well work, two (2) copies of Form WR-35, "Well Operator's Report of Drilling, Fracturing and/or Stimulating or Physical Change," containing in proper form the geological information required by W. Va. Code §22-6-22..."

To abate the violation you must:
The owner or operator shall submit a completed Well Operator's Report of Well Work "WR-35 form" to initiate the release of the well work permit. All job logs must be attached. Also, a written narrative must be submitted that explains all details of the work and the reason(s) why the WR-35 form was not submitted timely (within 90 days following the work).


A copy of this notice has been posted at the well site and sent by certified or registered mail to the person or Designated Agent named above.

You are hereby granted until 8/24/2017, to abate this violation.

Failure to abate the violation by that date will result in bond forfeiture and may result in assessment of civil penalties, filing of misdemeanor charges and/or an action for injunctive relief.

An informal conference with the Oil and Gas inspector should be arranged prior to the date set forth above for abatement of the violation.

If you wish to contest this violation, refer to procedures outlined in West Virginia Code 22-6-4.
