**INTRODUCTION**

This Order (hereinafter “Order”) is issued by the Office of Oil and Gas (hereinafter “OOG”), by and through its Chief, pursuant to the authority of West Virginia Code §§ 22-1-1 *et seq.*, 22-6-2 and 22-12-1 *et seq.* to C.I. McKown & Son, Inc.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

In support of this Order, the Chief hereby finds the following:

1. C.I. McKown & Son, Inc. was issued underground injection control permit number 2D0871106 from the Office of Oil and Gas to inject waste fluids from oil and natural gas exploration and development in well API # 47-087-01106 on April 10, 2012 with an expiration date of April 10, 2017.
2. C.I. McKown & Son, Inc. submitted a reissuance application package to renew UIC permit 2D0871106 on October 11, 2016.

3. The Office of Oil and Gas is currently reviewing the reissuance application package for UIC permit 2D0871106.
