INTRODUCTION

This Order (hereinafter "Order") is issued by the Office of Oil and Gas (hereinafter "OOG"), by and through its Chief, pursuant to the authority of West Virginia Code §§ 22-1-1 et seq., 22-6-2 and 22-12-1 et seq. to C.I. McKown & Son, Inc.

FINDINGS OF FACT

In support of this Order, the Chief hereby finds the following:

- C.I. McKown & Son, Inc. was issued underground injection control permit number
 2D0871106 from the Office of Oil and Gas to inject waste fluids from oil and natural
 gas exploration and development in well API # 47-087-01106 on April 10, 2012 with an
 expiration date of April 10, 2017.
- C.I. McKown & Son, Inc. submitted a reissuance application package to renew UIC permit 2D0871106 on October 11, 2016.
